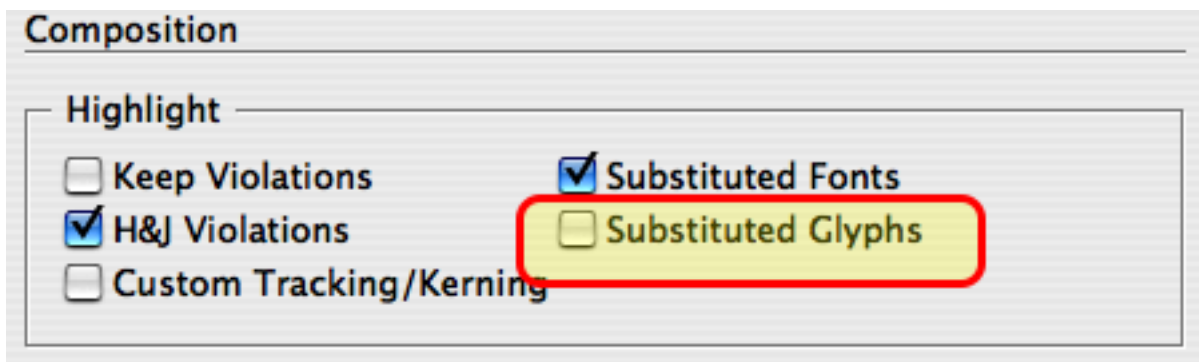

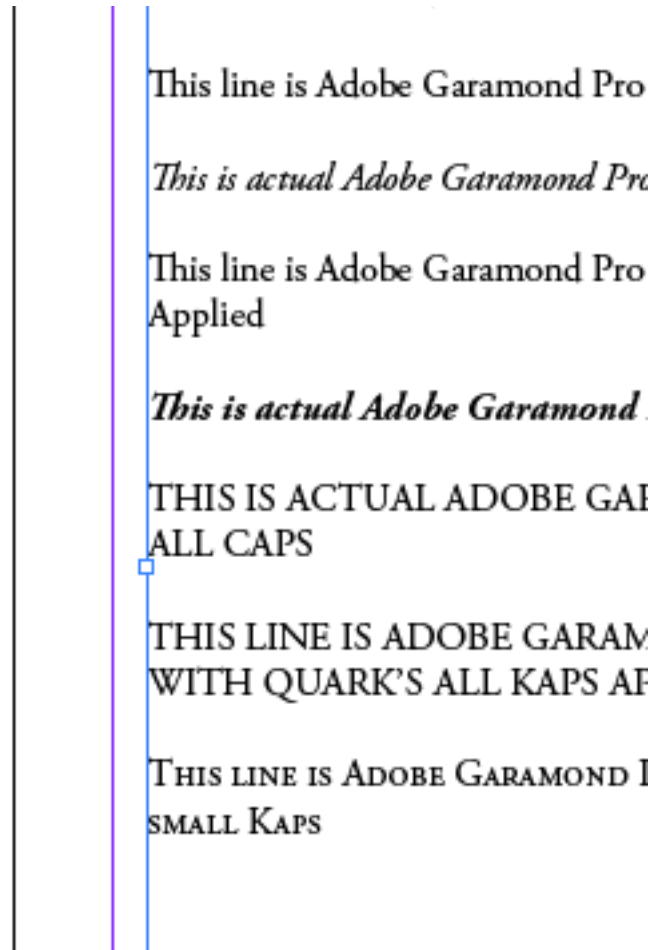
InDesign's Composition Highlight Prefs

Reasons why you may see yellow highlighted text in your converted Quark document

- 1) Your Quark document uses a menu style such as ALL CAPS or SMALL CAPS
- 2) Your Quark document uses a menu style applied to a font and the actual font does not exist, for example your Quark doc has Didot with Italic and Bold menu styles applied. If you do not actually have a DidotBoldItalic font loaded you will see either pink or yellow highlighted text in your converted InDesign document.
- 3) Your Quark doc has items designated as ligatures by InDesign, these are typically things like fi, fl, where pairs of letters in the Quark doc get handled differently by InDesign. You can turn off ligatures in InDesign, but then you lose a pretty cool typographical feature.
