Issues Resolved In Version 1.4

- Resolved an issue that allowed certain font files to remain open, which could result in a crash.
- Resolved an issue calculating the ink density in stored images.
- Resolved an issue with information displayed in the Tables, Object Styles, and Trap Styles reports.

New Features In Version 1.3

- Support for Mac OSX 10.4 Tiger.
- Displaying Policies file name on the palette.
- Outputting Policies as a report.

Issues Resolved In Version 1.3

- Text Policies were not being updated when font status was changed.
- In some cases the Y% scale value was being displayed as the X% scale value.
- Negative picas/ciceros were displayed incorrectly.
- Approved Colors/Fonts lists were not functioning correctly.
- Locked rules would remain locked when creating a new or opening a policy.
- Calculating Ink Density on certain images could cause a crash.
- Effective resolution was not being calculated correctly.

Issues Resolved In Version 1.2r2

- QuarkXPress® 6.X will crash if multiple layouts are created .(RT# 15966)

Issues Resolved In Version 1.2

- The document's size attributes were being displayed in points instead of inches.(RT# 11991)
- Rounding off decimals based on the user's digit preference.(RT# 15859)
- Studio will now ignore a line if the stroke has no weight.(RT# 15860)
- Image resolutions not being displayed accurately.(RT# 18561)
- The "Show Tools" preference would not update the pallet window(RT# 15862).
- Flat encoded images would cause a crash when scanning.(RT# 15864)
- Unused Styles were not being flagged properly.(RT# 15865)

- When in Lighthouse mode, prompt is given to fix items, but nothing happens.(RT# 15866)
- Style Sheet character styles would become bold if rule is switched to "does not equal."(RT# 15867)
- The language of a Paragraph Style was not being displayed correctly.(RT# 15869)
- Overflow text boxes were being detected but not reported.(RT# 15870)
- The language of Paragraph Style was not being displayed correctly. (RT# 15869)
- Checking for the physical existence of a Color Profile caused the Profile Policy to be flagged even when the names matched..(RT# 15871)
- Fixing a Baseline Shift was not being calculated based on the point size. (RT # 1584)
- The Policy "Spread Page Count" has been changed to "Extra Pages" and can be used to detect when there are extra pages in a spread (more than 2 for a facing pages document and more than 1 for non-facing)
- Some menu-styled fonts were not being correctly reported.(RT# 15872)
- Fixed a bug that would cause a crash if no printer was attached to the system(RT# 15873).

Improvements:

- Improved performance for "fixing" flagged items.
- Separated Character and Paragraph Style Sheets into two Policy sets.
 Note: If you want to check Character Style Sheets you should add them using "Add Policy." Or simply delete the "Default Policies.fcs" file and a new file will be automatically created.
- The "Greek Below" and "Subset Fonts" default Policies have been changed so that they now use the "<" (less than) equation.
